WITNESS THIS AGREEMENT dated this _____ day of ______, in the year_____, by and between The Mid-South Dressage Academy, Elizabeth G. Clifton, Clifton Farms and TDE, LP, hereinafter call The Stable and _______, hereinafter referred to as User, and if the User is a minor, the User's parent or guardian, _______. For consideration received, and in return for the use, today and on all future dates of the property, facilities and services of The Stable. The Stable's owners, instructors, employees, drivers and agents; User, User's heirs, assigns, and representatives, hereby agree as follows:

INHERENT RISKS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK. The undersigned acknowledges there are inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below, and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in ways such as , running , bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them, the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions, collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

User acknowledges that horses, by their very nature are unpredictable and subject to animal whim. User assumes all risks in connection therewith, and expressly waives any claims for any injury or loss arising there from. User agrees to abide by and follow The Stable's rules and regulations, which shall be posted and/or available from time to time. User further acknowledges that the behavior of any animal is contingent to some extent upon the ability of User. User assumes all risks therefore and warrants a full and fair disclosure of User's abilities has been made to the Stable.

User agrees to assume any and all risks involved in or arising out of User's use of any equipment of livestock pertaining to the rental of horses or taking of riding lessons, the use of any arena on the premises of the Stable and for purposes of taking riding lessons either on the premises or lessons given off the premises by Stable personnel.

USER (OR USER'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN IF USER IS A MINOR) AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND THE STABLE AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTION, DAMAGES, JUDGMENTS, ORDERS, COSTS OR EXPENSES, INCLUDING ATTORNEY'S FEES, WHICH MAY IN ANY WAY ARISE FROM, OR BE IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH USER'S USE OF OR PRESENCE UPON THE PROPERTY OF THE STABLE AND THE FACILITIES LOCATED THEREON. In the event User is a minor, the parent or guardian shall further indemnify, defend and The Stable harmless from any such claims by said minor child.

In the event User is using User's own horse, or a horse(s) not owned by The Stable, User warrants said horse(s) shall be free from infection, contagious or transmittable diseases. The Stable reserves the right to refuse access or use of any horse upon the premises that does not appear to The Stable to be in good health, or is deemed dangerous or undesirable.

User agrees to waive the protection of any applicable statutes in the jurisdiction whose purpose, substance and/or effect is to provide that a general release shall not extent to claims, material or otherwise, which the person giving the release does not know or suspect to exist at the time of executing said release.
